

Highlights of Dr. Sugarbaker & Dr. Gonzalez's Historical Visit to China



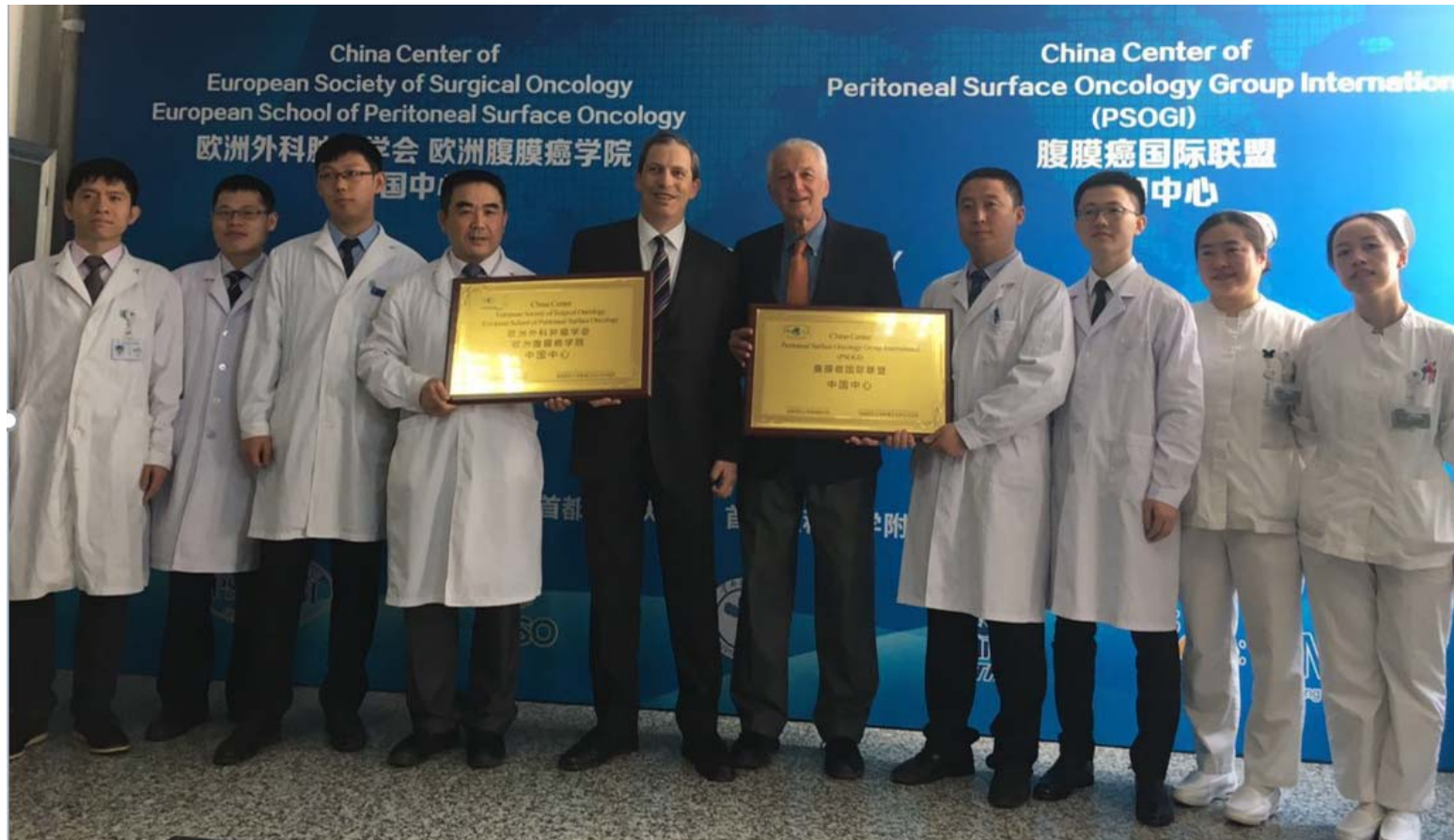

China Center Opening Ceremony



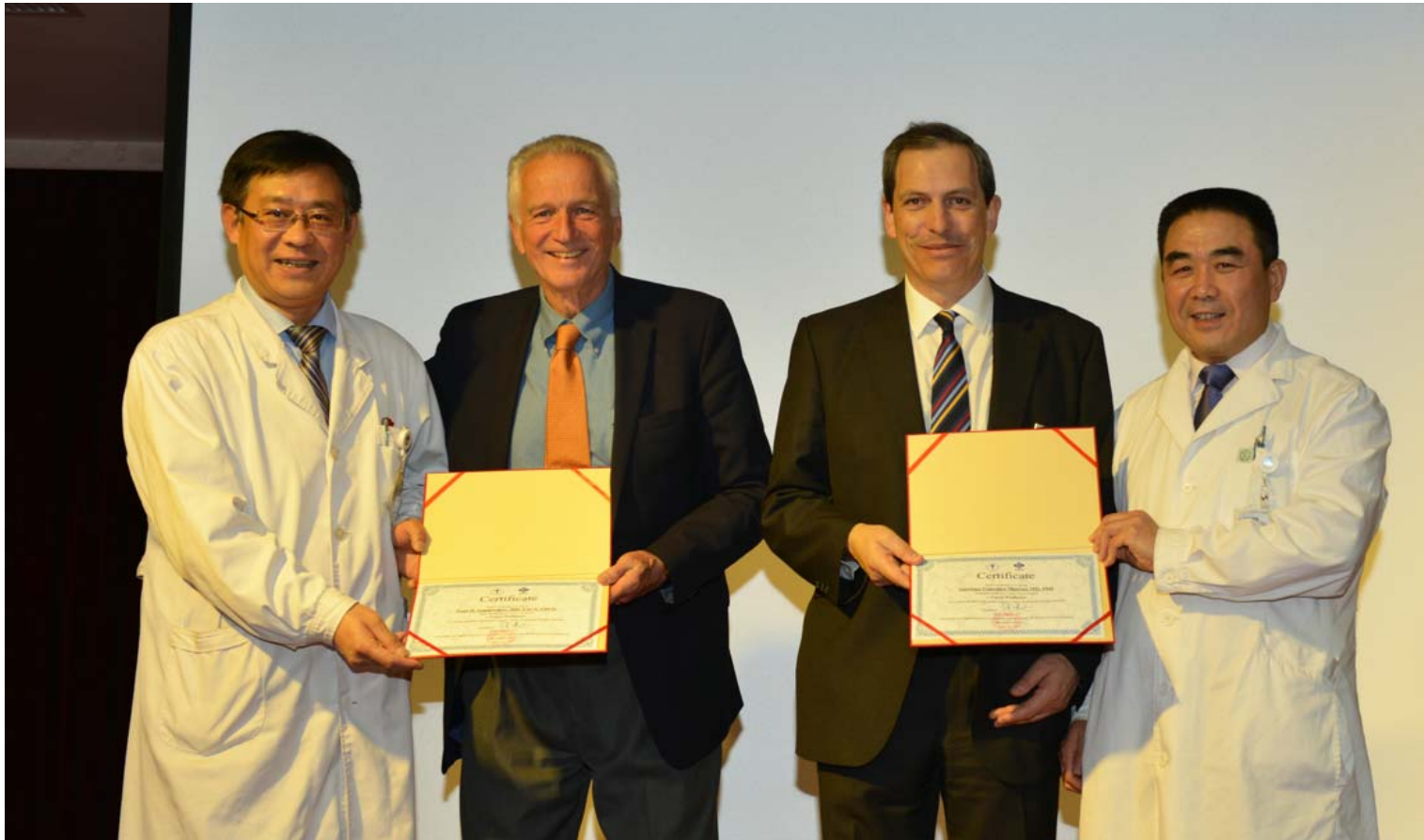

Ward Round at Beijing Shijitan Hospital



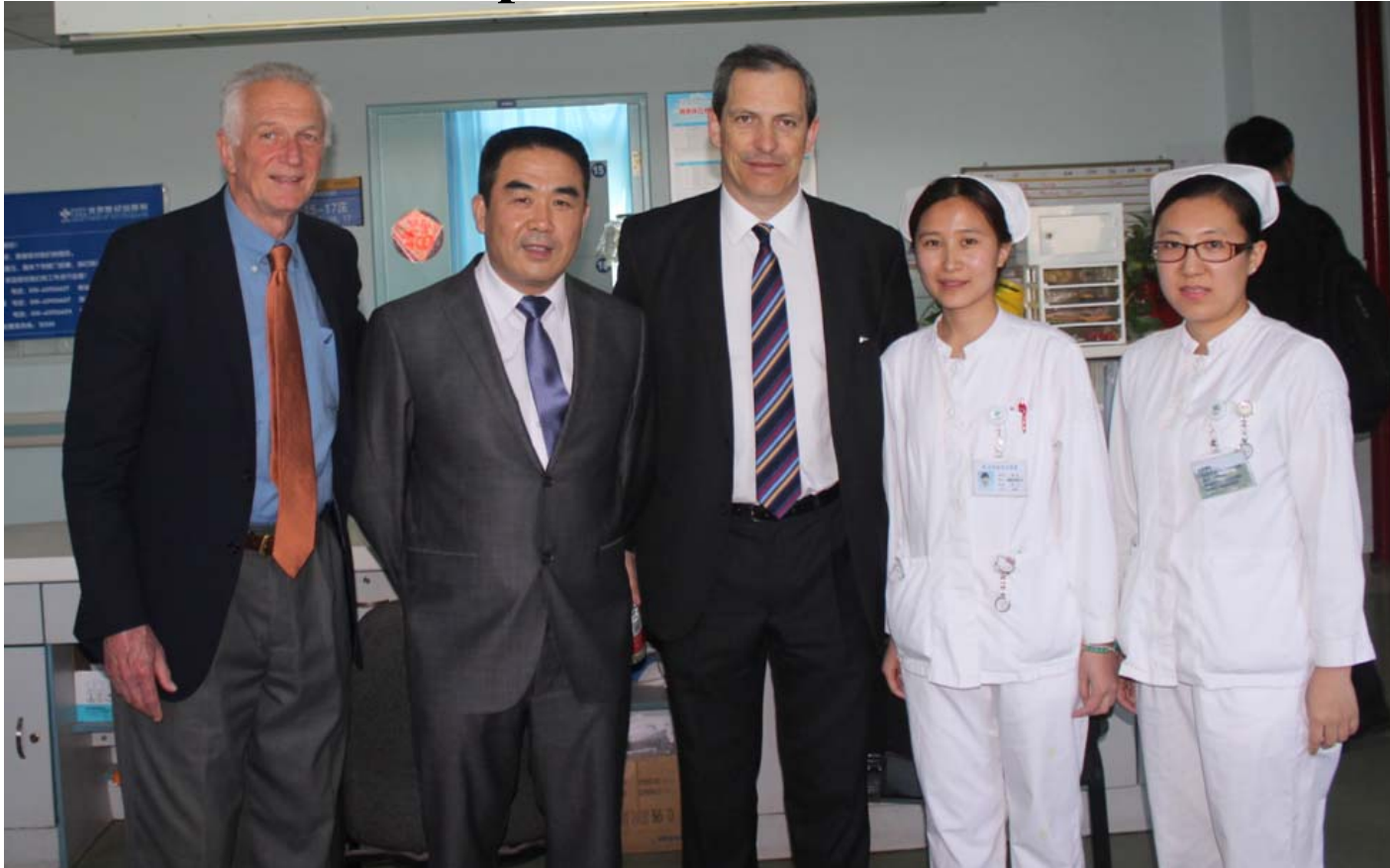
